Preface

Government have many developmental and welfare schemes, common people have the need of initiatives taken for development and welfare. But the fact is that, the link between the both is very poor. Common people often remain unable to reach the Government developmental initiatives. Government mechineries, due to lake of man power and close touch with the needy people, can not provide the benefit of the developmental schemes as planned or desired. The role of Non Governmental Organisations to link the common people with the Government Schemes is very important. Society for North East Handmade Paper Development, i.e. SNEHPAD has been doing this duty of linking the both since inception. During the year 2013-14 also, SNEHPAD made all the efforts to make the common people and the target groups aware about various developmental schemes, to train the officials and workers associated with implementation of the schemes, to encourage the group activities in socio-economic development sector and to ensure socio-economic security of the needy and deprived people.

During the year 2013-14, **SNEHPAD** tried to train the Panchayat Members, Mates and other people associated with implementation of **Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Gurrantee Act – 2005 (MGNREGA). MGNREGA** is an act which not only ensures employment of the workable persons of rural BPL families, but also develop rural infrastructure, conserve soil and water, develop soil fertility, protect environment and support the poorest of the poor to upgrade their present status of living. **SNEHPAD** covered 53 numbers of Gram Panchayats of Baghchung Development Block, Titabor Development Block and Selenghat Development Block, Jorhat and trained all the GP Presidents, Members, Mates and others involved with implementation of the Act in the said GPs to make them more efficient and active.

SNEHPAD also took the responsibility to encourage group activity among rural women to make them economically self sufficient and to empower them in every aspect. **National Rural Livelihoods Mission (NRLM)** is a Government initiative to develop group activity among rural women and to empower them accordingly. **SNEHPAD** organised 18 numbers of Awareness Meet on NRLM and covered about 2000 rural woman involved with SHGs under Dhekorgorah Developoment Block. SNEHPAD also organised 6 numbers of SHG and JLG Management Training Programmes and 5 numbers of Micro Enterprise Development Programmes for intensive training of about 400 group leaders.

Agriculture is one of the most important subjects to concentrate upon. **SNEHPAD** organised Workshops on **Kishan Credit Card (KCC)**, Integrated as well as Organic Faming, and Livestock Management in remote villages and covered 1245 numbers of farmers. By this initiative, SNEHPAD tried to develop the mindset and to introduce about latest developments in the farm sector.

SNEHPAD, in the year 2013-14, continued Integrated Village Development Activity in 4 adopted villages, continued **Micro Finance Activities** to provide financial and **insurance support** to the umployed youths, farmers and women. Like past years, SNEHPAD continued its raw material and marketing supports to weavers, artisans and SHGs.

During the year **SNEHPAD** observed important days like World Environment Day, World Human Rights Day, International Brotherhood Day, National Youth Day etc and introduced an Innovative Programme named "Vivek Briksha". Under this programme SNEHPAD distributed 1000 saplings of fruit bearing and other trees of medicinal value. During this year **SNEHPAD also signed an MOU with NEIST** to implement a DST supported **Handloom Cluster Development** at New Sonowal, Moriani, Jorhat

SNEHPAD will take the opportunity to thank SIRD, NABARD, NEDFI, RMK, NEIST, Forest Department, AAU, KVK, RFRI, LICI for their support and encouragement.

1. Workshops, Short Term Training Programmes

A) Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Gurantee Act – 2005(MGNREGA), is a big initiative of the Government of India to ensure employment of rural unskilled unemployed people, to develop rural infrastructure, to protect environment and to conserve soil and water bodies. If the Act is implemented properly, the prosperity of rural areas can be ensured. Therefore, to train the people involved with implementation of MGNREGA to make them more efficient, SNEHPAD organised short term training programmes in following Gram Panchayats of Jorhat District under financial support received from SIRD, Jorhat. Officials of Soil Conservation Department, Concerned Development Blocks, Agriculture Department, Rain Forest Research Institute (RFRI) and SNEHPAD were invited as Resource Persons to conduct technical sessions.

2. Group activity promotion and Self Help Group development
